**Give Wholeheartedly** Philippians 2:5-16, Colossians 3:23-25,

Will He hear words of gratitude as you experience His great mercy and grace? Will He see anticipation and hope as you recognize His call? Will He observe joy, patience, and endurance as you give your utmost in response to His invitation?
