# Feast on This – Tabernacles

Leviticus 23:33-43

Every Christian is invited to the Feast of Tabernacles in the future millennium, but you don't have to wait to feast on God's presence. God invites you to come to the table and feast on His goodness today. What are you waiting for?

**1 John 5:13, John 14:15-17, Romans 8:16, John 5:24**

You don't have to wait and worry if you were good enough, or if you got it right in this life. The Bible is written for you so that you can know that you have eternal life. A true child of God has the undeniable presence of the Holy Spirit living within. How does the Spirit of God confirm to you that you are saved?

**Hebrews 4:14-16, Jeremiah 33:3, Psalm 18:1-3, Psalm 84:10-12**

You don't have to wait to meet with God or to experience His presence; you have an open invitation to the throne of grace. You may not only come to Him with boldness, but you can be certain to find mercy and grace at the just right moment. Where do you turn when things get difficult? Do you run to Him first?

**John 10:27-30, Hebrews 4:12, 2 Timothy 3:16-17, Psalm 119:105**

You don't have to wait to hear what God will say, you have His Word now. In the Bible, you will find the complete counsel of God. Regardless of your physical situation or your emotional condition, God's Word brings perspective and clarity, security and comfort. How are you taking advantage of the gift of God's Word? Are you hiding nuggets of truth in your heart so that the Spirit can bring it to your attention when you need it most?
