

PDO LEAD TEACHER

JOB DESCRIPTION

ACCOUNTABLE TO: PDO COORDINATOR

OVERVIEW:

» The lead teacher will foster a loving and nurturing environment for preschoolers to explore, learn and enjoy. The teacher is responsible for creating an inviting classroom space that invites the children to feel loved and safe.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- » Must be a born again believer (John 3:3)
- » Committed to walking in a manner worthy of his calling in all circumstances exhibiting integrity, honesty, purity, etc. (Ephesians 4:1)
- » Live life as one who loves God and his neighbor (Matthew 22:36-40)
- » Exhibit both administrative and interpersonal maturity.
- » Possess the over-arching vision of TBC and be able to work as a team member to carry out that vision.
- » Passionate to help children discover Jesus as Savior and become followers of Jesus Christ.
- » Have a servant heart and see ministry as a calling not a job.

POSITION EXPECTATION:

- » Be able to observe, hear and respond to children, emergencies, conflicts that may arise in the classroom.
- » Be able to lift children from the floor, bend down to a child's height or sit on the floor.
- » Must be confident that he/she can handle daily contact with staff, parents and children and coordinate with the PDO Coordinator when necessary to address tense or challenging situations.
- » Plan, supervise and implement daily classroom activities that address the spiritual, physical, emotional, social and mental needs of the children.
- » Prepare lesson plans and turn them into the PDO Coordinator each month using the curriculum and resources provided or other approved sources.
- » Treat children with dignity and respect and follow the discipline formula. Communicate discipline concerns with the PDO Coordinator and parents.
- » Responsible for creating an ordered classroom including décor, arrangement and learning environment.
- » Will attend all staff meeting and training sessions.
- » Will implement methods for utilizing the assistant teacher, including weekly, clear communications and supervision.
- » Will plan and implement methods for being a positive parent liason. Including monthly newsletters, daily contact, open house and teacher conferences.
- » Evaluate the spiritual, social, emotional and intellectual level of each child and make adjustments as necessary.
- » Maintain a current infant/child CPR and first aid certification.
- » Report all supply and maintenance needs to the PDO Coordinator through the proper channels.
